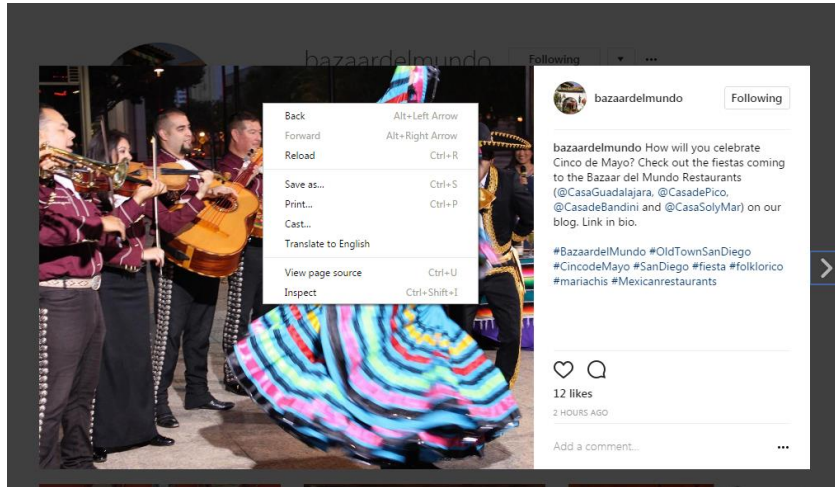
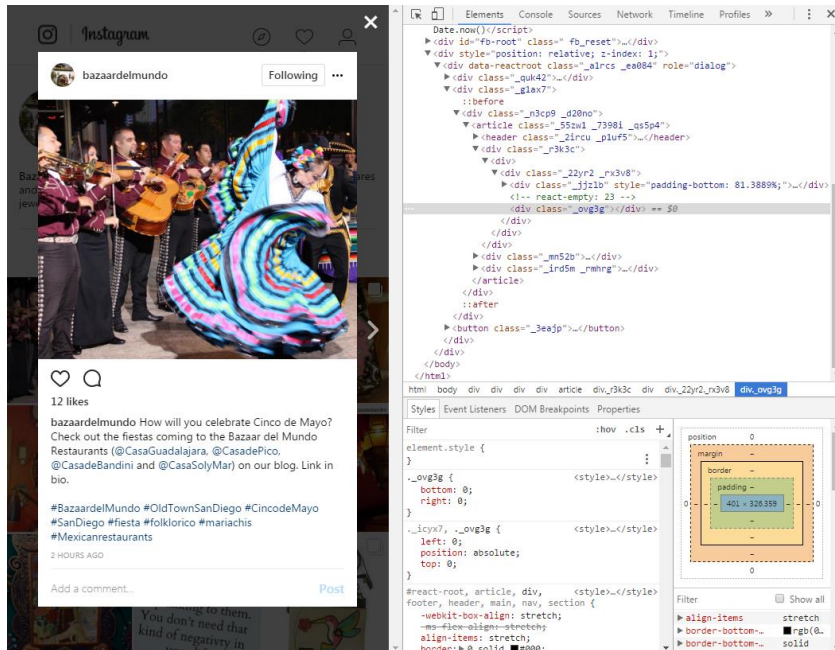


How to Save Photos on Instagram Directly to Your Device

1. Select the image you want to save and then use your secondary click (or “right click”) to view your options.



2. Select “Inspect,” which will bring you to this screen:

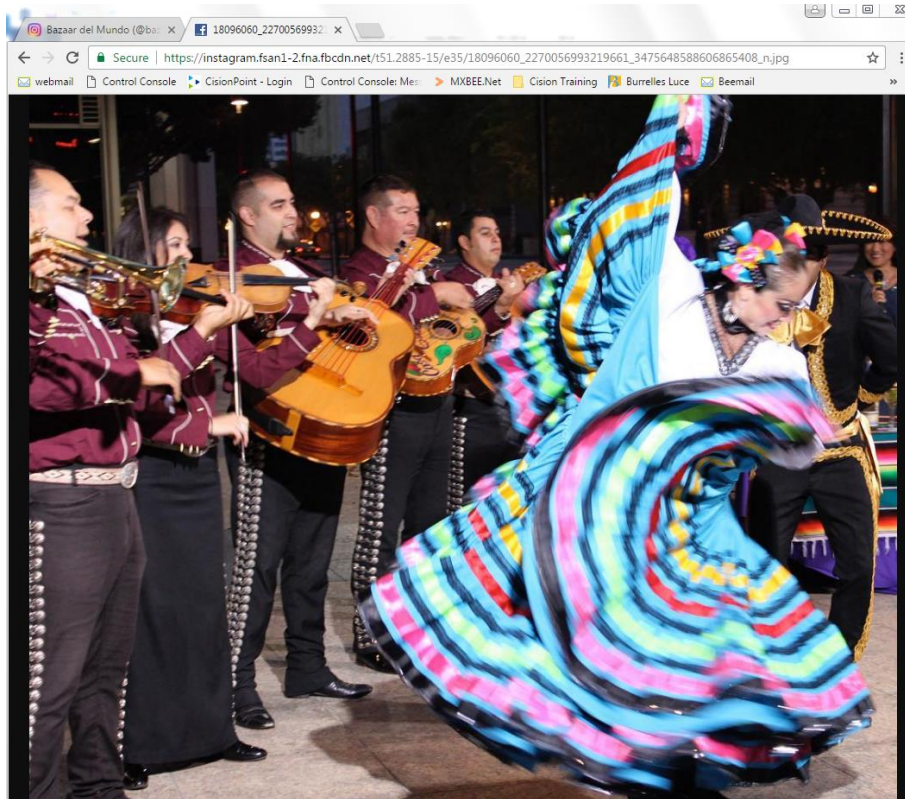


3. Use the dropdown arrows to reveal the image's URL
